Translational Sub-Study Storing and Shipping of Samples

Collection of Translational Tissue Samples

As per the patient information and written informed consent for the main trial, recruited patients have the option to provide tissue samples from the hysterectomy and BSO +/- lymphadenectomy.

Sites will be requested to provide formalin-fixed paraffin-embedded (FFPE) tissue from the surgical resection, namely one block containing representative tumour from the hysterectomy and BSO specimen and, for Arm 1 patients only, one block containing tumour from lymph nodes.

Details of shipping will be provided at a later date. In brief, samples will be forwarded to a central site within each international trial group and then onto a central laboratory. An international consortium with participating experts representing the collaborating international trial groups will agree the programme of translational work, to include molecular and biomarker studies. Use of the samples will be subject to separate funding and ethics approval as applicable.
